An award will be made to a young musician or singer identified through the Fèis movement who offers exceptional potential and can demonstrate how an international experience would add to their musical development.

In the year it celebrates its 80th anniversary, the Saltire Society has invited Fèisean nan Gàidheal to seek proposals from the Fèis network and to select an individual to receive a Student Travel Bursary. The award will be made on 30th November at the **Saltire Celebrates** event at Òran Mòr in Glasgow. The winning musician or singer will also perform at that event.

To be considered applicants should be under 30 years old, currently studying, and should submit a CV with accompanying material detailing experience up until now as well as a description of the project they would undertake with the travel bursary and how this opportunity would enhance their creative development.

The award and any commendations and special mentions (in the form of a certificate) will be made to the selected musician, consisting of £1,500 to enable the winner to pursue a research project, including international travel related to their practice, together with a certificate and membership of the Saltire Society. The winner will be expected to present a personal visual record of their experiences at an award ceremony in the following year. The Society would welcome interaction through Facebook, Twitter and blogging to record on-going responses.

All nominated entrants will receive one year's membership of the Saltire Society.
